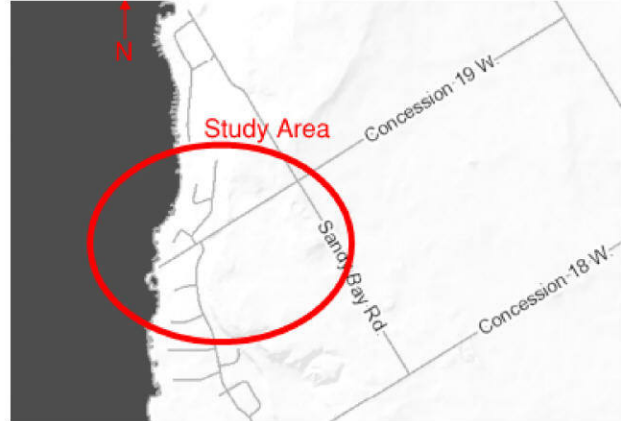




Notice of Study Commencement Castle Cove Pump Station No. 4 Improvements Municipal Class Environmental Assessment

The Study

The Township of Tiny ("Township") has initiated a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) to consider improvements to the Castle Cove Pump Station No. 4, located at 947 Concession 19 West, Tiny. The Township has identified a need to consider improvements to the Castle Cove Pumping Station due to the limited space available within the existing pump station building to complete regular operation and maintenance activities, and in accordance with the Township's Health and Safety initiatives and water system improvement plans.



Alternative solutions include: 1) Do Nothing, 2) Expand the pump station building at the current location, 3) Decommission the existing pump station building and construct a replacement pump station at an alternative municipally owned location.

The Process

This study is being carried out in accordance with the requirements of a Schedule B undertaking as outlined in the Municipal Engineers Association Municipal Class Environmental Assessment document (2000, as amended in 2007 and 2011).

Public & Agency Input Invited

Public input and comments are invited for incorporation into the planning and design of this project. Subject to comments received and the receipt of necessary approvals, the Township intends to proceed with the planning, design and construction of this project.
