





Pollinators are any insect or animal that moves pollen to a plant, allowing for fertilization. To benefit pollinators, in 2016, the Township of Tiny planted 8 meadows in 6 different public green spaces for a total of 2018 m² of new pollinator habitat. Those meadows replaced mowed grass areas and continue to provide a range of flowers and foliage throughout the Spring, Summer, and Fall seasons.
