

BY-LAW NUMBER 1458.

Of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Tiny to prohibit the disposal or piling of snow on Highways.


WHEREAS under the provisions of Section 417 of the Municipal Act, R.S.C., 1960, the Council of every municipality has jurisdiction over all highways and bridges within the municipality.


THEREFORE, be it enacted and it is hereby enacted, that it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, to obstruct any highway within the limits of the Township of Tiny by bringing snow from other properties, and disposing or piling the said snow on a highway.

Any person contravening the provision of this by-law shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty not to exceed \$25.00, at the discretion of the convicting magistrate.

This by-law shall have force and take effect immediately after the final passing thereof.

By-law read a first, second, and third time and finally passed with the consent of the majority of the whole number of the members of the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Tiny this 3rd. day of February, A. D., 1964.

BY LAW NUMBER 1458
