Township of Tiny raises \$45,000 at Mayor’s Charity Golf Tournament for local charitable organizations in North Simcoe

The event featured an 11:00 a.m. shotgun start, a delicious plated dinner, a silent auction valued at more than \$8,500, a 50/50 jackpot of \$712, in addition to various on-course competitions and prizes.
