Activity Schedule

- This activity allows youth to compete against friends in a Nintendo Switch Mario Kart Tournament on a large screen and play immersive VR gaming with Meta Quest 3.
- Free pizza, popcorn, and drinks provided in a relaxed, youth-only space.

Youth Pickleball Open Play

- Saturday, May 2, 2026, from 11:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. at Perkinsfield Park Pavilion
- This activity reserves the courts just for youth to enjoy the game of pickleball rain or shine. All skill levels are welcome, and equipment is provided.
- Free pizza is available in this casual, drop-in event. Registration is required (in advance or on site) with parent/guardian waiver.

Life-Sized Board Games Café and Craft Corner

- Monday, May 4, 2026, from 4:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. at the Wyebridge Community Centre
- This activity allows youth to enjoy giant versions of classic games like Connect 4 and Jenga, play trivia, and create crafts to take home, while listening to music.
- Café-style snacks and beverages are provided in this youth-focused community space.
