Council Commences a Review of the Township of Tiny Strategic Plan – Resident Input Welcome!

On April 17, 2019, Township of Tiny Council will meet to review the current Strategic Plan. Developed in 2015, the current Strategic Plan was developed with broad input from residents, stakeholders and key partners. It articulates a Vision for the Township and defines a set of important goals and key actions that were identified as ‘top of mind’ back in 2015.

Strategic Plans are visionary documents and the Township’s current document set a bold path forward by identifying some of the issues facing the Township as well as a number of strategic opportunities.

Strategic Plans – in fact Plans of any kind – are only as good as the implementation that follows. Since 2015, Township Council and staff have been working to realize results and to ensure that progress on key issues remains top-of-mind. Since 2015, a number of important achievements and marks of progress have been made. That said, more work remains to be done. The world today is markedly different from that which existed some four years ago. We have a new provincial government in place, an upcoming Federal election and new residents who have come to live, work, play and learn here. It is therefore vital that Council review the Strategic Plan to ensure that the priorities that are identified therein remain relevant and reflective of the issues that are indeed top of mind for the community.
