Re: Changes to Roadside Parking on

Centre Beach Road and Thunder Bay Lane

Reference: Municipal Law Enforcement Report MLE-041-19

Each year Council reviews and implements various changes to improve the parking systems in the Township of Tiny. These changes have been based on public feedback from residents and visitors to our Township.

One of the concerns identified was improved signage and safety on the abovementioned streets identified through Deputations and Petitions to Council. At Council's direction, staff prepared the above referenced report after reviewing the existing parking conditions and conducting site inspections at the various locations.

- 1. In the case of <u>Centre Beach Road</u> (Both Sides), Council directed staff to remove all posts and signs and deem the road an Emergency Access Road and place posts and signs at the entrances of Centre Beach Road. This change prohibits parking on the entire roadway and was adopted to provide for improved road safety and a consistent signage pattern along the entire road.
- 2. In the case of Thunder Bay Lane Council directed staff to consolidate the two existing Permit Parking Areas (6 spaces) onto one side of the road (South Side). This change was adopted to ensure better traffic flow.

Council approved these changes at the November 13, 2019 Council Meeting and provided funding through the Budget Approval passed on January 27, 2020.
