Lafontaine Beach Park, Beach Water Quality Improvements
Class Environmental Assessment Study

The Study

The Township of Tiny has completed the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA) Schedule B process for the Lafontaine Beach Park, Beach Water Quality Improvements Project. The Township of Tiny has studied the problem of low water issues and poor water quality at the Lafontaine Beach Park and established the preferred approach for the Lafontaine Beach Park, Beach Water Quality Improvements. The Township examined alternative solutions to improving water quality issues at Lafontaine Beach Park. Options included the review of; do nothing and the partial or full removal of existing groynes. Through the study process, the causes for poor water quality were identified, coastal processes and water levels were analyzed and the preferred alternative for the study area was selected as Partial Removal, capping and Beach Fill.

The Process

This study has been carried out in accordance with the requirements of a Schedule "B" undertaking as outlined in the Municipal Engineers Association Municipal Class Environmental Assessment document (2000, as amended in 2007 and 2011). A Project File Report ("PFR") has been prepared to document the planning and decision-making process undertaken for this study.

The PFR is being placed on the public record for a 60-day review period ending February 5, 2014, at 4:30 p.m., in accordance with the requirements of the Municipal Class EA. The PFR is available for viewing on the Township's website at <http://www.tinv.ca> and at the following location:

If concerns regarding this project cannot be resolved in discussion with the Township and Aqua Solutions 5 Inc., a person or party may request that the Minister of Environment make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act (referred to as a Part II Order)—Requests for a Part II Order must be received by the Minister, at the address below, by Wednesday, February 5, 2014 at 4:30 p.m. A copy of the request must also be sent to the Township of Tiny (see above) by this date. If no request received by Wednesday, February 5, 2014 at 4:30 p.m., the Township may proceed with design and construction as outlined in the PFR.
