## MARRIAGE LICENSE REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicants must be 18 years of age or over OR parental consent is required. Parental consent (from both parents) is required for applicants 16 and 17 years of age. You need to be at least 16 years old to get married in Ontario.
2. A marriage license can only be issued to the applicant and/or joint applicant.
3. Both parties must sign the marriage license application form. The marriage license can be issued to one or both of the applicants. When issued to only one of the applicants, the required identification of the absent party must be produced.
4. Two of the following valid pieces of identification are required for each applicant, with one piece containing a current photo:
  - ◆ Birth Certificate
  - ◆ Current Passport with photo
  - ◆ Record of Immigrant Landing
  - ◆ Canadian Citizenship Card
  - ◆ Driver's License
  - ◆ Ontario Health Card with photo
  - ◆ Ontario Photo ID Card
  - ◆ Secure Indian Status Card

Photocopies are not accepted. Documents not in English or French must be translated by a certified translator.

5. If you live at R.R. # or if you have a box number as an address, we require the actual civic address.
6. If you are divorced, we require the **ORIGINAL** Judgment or Certificate of Divorce or Decree Absolute or a **CERTIFIED COPY** of same by the court which granted the divorce. **An uncertified copy is not accepted.**
7. For divorces outside of Canada, please refer to the Authorization section of the Requirements Respecting Marriage in Ontario information sheet (attached).
8. A death certificate is not required if you are a widow/widower.
9. A marriage license is valid in Ontario only for a period of three (3) months from the date of issue. There is no waiting period.
10. License fee: \$125.00 (Cash or Debit Card)
11. Office Hours: 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday to Friday. Please note that a marriage application will not be processed after 4:00 p.m.
