Removal of Temporary Beach Encroachments (Unattended/Stored Items on Municipal Property)

The Township of Tiny is committed to improving access and enjoyment of municipally-owned parks and beaches, while at the same time respecting privately-owned property. To this end, the Township implemented a Beach Enjoyment Strategy Tiny (BEST Strategy) in 2017 to address, on a complaints basis, temporary encroachments throughout the Township.

Residents and visitors are reminded that personal items/private property cannot be left unattended or overnight on municipally-owned property. Personal property cannot be stored on municipal property. This includes but is not limited to chairs, watercrafts, barbeques, boat launches/docks/lifts, decks/platforms, fire pits, delineation, umbrellas and tents.

Items left unattended or stored on municipal property will be removed by the Township at the owner's expense.
