Re: Changes to Roadside Parking – Both sides of Shelly Lane

Ref: Municipal Law Enforcement Report MLE-038-21

At the May 19, 2021 Committee of the Whole meeting Council reviewed and discussed correspondence regarding suggested changes to parking on Shelly Lane. At that time both sides of Shelly Lane were considered Permit Parking through the Parking Strategy signage posted at the entrance points to this area.

Subsequently at the September 22, 2021 Committee of the Whole meeting Council received Municipal Law Enforcement Report MLE-038-21 regarding Shelly Lane – Proposed Parking Restrictions outlining recommendations from Public Works Department, Fire Department and Municipal Law Enforcement.

At the October 13, 2021 Council meeting, Council Approved Recommendation 299/21 directing staff to proceed with Option #1 to install NO PARKING signage on the north side of Shelly Lane and install parallel Permit Parking signage on the south side of Shelly Lane. Additionally, 1 Accessible Parking space is to be established at the end of the road on the south side. These changes are being implemented to improve road safety and clarify parking expectations. Please find attached an illustration of the parking changes.

You are being provided notice of this change as your property is adjacent to and within 50 meters of the parking changes. Full details are available on our website at <a href="https://www.tiny.ca">www.tiny.ca</a> on the Parking Webpage.
