Municipal Law Enforcement Update June 18 to 20, 2021

Date: June 22, 2021

(Tiny, Ontario) Over the period of June 18 to 20, 2021, the Township of Tiny By-law Officers were on full patrol responding to calls that range from noise, dogs, litter, fireworks and COVID-related complaints.

As a result, Township By-law Officers patrolled a total of 193 km via bike patrol and responded to 64 complaints. By-law Officers issued 97 parking tickets for illegally parked vehicles in problem areas, that carry a \$90.00 fine, as increased in 2021. By-law Officers issued one charge for a dog on Balm Beach. As per [By-law 02-115, as amended](#) dogs are prohibited on Balm Beach between June 1 to September 30.

By-law Officers issued one charge for a dog Cawaja Beach. As per [By-law #19-040](#) dogs are prohibited on Cawja Beach between 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., June 1 to September 30.

By-law Officers also issued one charge for use of a barbeque at the beach. As per [By-law 12-032](#), Section 7, no person shall be permitted to have a barbeque upon any boardwalk or beach owned by the Township of Tiny.

By-law Officers issued one charge for burning without a fire permit which has a fine of \$365.00.

Fire permits can be purchased through the Township of Tiny Office, at 130 Balm Beach Road West, Perkinsfield from Monday to Friday (9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.). A reminder to community members that, as per [By-law #06-031](#), water restrictions are in effect all year. Odd number houses may water on odd numbered days and even numbered houses may water on even numbered days. Outdoor water usage is permitted from 5:00 to 8:00 a.m. and from 7:00 to 10:00 p.m. on odd or even numbered days.

If you are seeding or laying down sod, a permit is available to extend watering times. Under the permit you may water from 7:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. every day for 14 days. Permits are \$25.00 each and are available at the Township of Tiny Municipal Office.

The Township of Tiny's Municipal Law Enforcement Officers will be enforcing instances of non-compliance. Concerns regarding non-compliance can be reported to the Municipal Law Enforcement Department at 705-526-4136. Non-compliance may result in the issuance of a warning or a charge, with a fine of \$180.00.
