## **Municipal Law Enforcement Update for June 25 to 27, 2021**

**Date:** June 29, 2021

**(Tiny, Ontario)** Over the period of June 25 to 27, 2021, the Township of Tiny By-law Officers were on full patrol responding to calls that range from noise, dogs, litter, fireworks and COVID-related complaints.

As a result, Township By-law Officers responded to 65 complaints. By-law Officers issued 29 parking tickets for illegally parked vehicles in problem areas, that carry a \$90.00 fine, as increased in 2021. By-law Officers issued one charge for a dog on Cawaja Beach. As per Township of Tiny [By-law #19-040](#) dogs are prohibited on Cawaja Beach between 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., from June 1 to September 30.

By-law Officers issued one charge for burning without a fire permit which has a fine of \$365.00. Fire permits can be purchased at the Township of Tiny Office, at 130 Balm Beach Road West, Perkinsfield Monday to Friday (9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.). The Township would like to remind residents and visitors of our Short-Term Rental Strict Enforcement Policy and related educational information posted on our website at [www.tiny.ca/Pages/Short-Term-Rental-Information.aspx](http://www.tiny.ca/Pages/Short-Term-Rental-Information.aspx).

This is also reminder that, as per Township of Tiny [By-law #06-031](#), outdoor water restrictions are in effect all year. Odd number houses may only water on odd numbered days and even numbered houses may only water on even numbered days. Outdoor water usage is also only permitted between the hours of 5:00 to 8:00 a.m. and from 7:00 to 10:00 p.m. on the days you are permitted to water.

If you are seeding or laying down sod, a permit is available to extend watering times. Under the permit you may water from 7:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. every day for 14 days. Permits are \$25.00 each and are available at the Township of Tiny Municipal Office.
