## **Municipal Law Enforcement Update for July 7 to 11, 2021**

**Date:** July 13, 2021

**(Tiny, Ontario)** Over the period of July 7 to 11, 2021, the Township of Tiny By-law Officers were on full patrol responding to calls that range from noise, dogs, litter, fireworks and COVID-related complaints.

As a result, Township By-law Officers patrolled a total of 202 km via bike patrol, responding to 57 complaints. By-law Officers issued 102 parking tickets for illegally parked vehicles in problem areas, that carry a \$90.00 fine, as increased in 2021. By-law Officers issued one (1) charge for a dog on Cawaja Beach. As per Township of Tiny [By-law #19-040](#) dogs are prohibited on Cawaja Beach between 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., from June 15 to September 15. Additionally, By-law Officers issued two (2) charges for dog(s) on Balm Beach. As per [By-law #02-115](#) dogs are prohibited on Balm Beach between June 1 and September 30.

The Township would like to remind residents and visitors of our Short-Term Rental Strict Enforcement Policy and related educational information posted on our website at [www.tiny.ca/Pages/Short-Term-Rental-Information.aspx](http://www.tiny.ca/Pages/Short-Term-Rental-Information.aspx).

This is also reminder that, as per Township of Tiny [By-law #06-031](#), outdoor water restrictions are in effect all year. Odd number houses may only water on odd numbered days and even numbered houses may only water on even numbered days. Outdoor water usage is also only permitted between the hours of 5:00 to 8:00 a.m. and from 7:00 to 10:00 p.m. on the days you are permitted to water.

If you are seeding or laying down sod, a permit is available to extend watering times. Under the permit you may water from 7:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. every day for 14 days. Permits are \$25.00 each and are available at the Township of Tiny Municipal Office.

The Township of Tiny's Municipal Law Enforcement Officers will be enforcing instances of non-compliance. Concerns regarding non-compliance can be reported to the Municipal Law Enforcement Department at 705-526-4136. Non-compliance may result in the issuance of a warning or a charge, with a fine of \$180.00.
