Municipal Law Enforcement Update for July 16 to 18, 2021

Date: July 22, 2021

(Tiny, Ontario) Over the period of July 16 to 18, 2021, the Township of Tiny By-law Officers were on full patrol responding to calls that range from noise, dogs, litter, fireworks and COVID-related complaints.

As a result, Township By-law Officers patrolled a total of 348 km via bike patrol, responding to 64 complaints. By-law Officers issued 88 parking tickets for illegally parked vehicles in problem areas, that carry a \$90.00 fine, as increased in 2021. By-law Officers issued one charge for failing to comply with the Terms and Conditions of a Class “A” burning permit which has a fine of \$180.00. The Township of Tiny would like to remind the community that fireworks [By-law 07-054](#), as amended, prohibits the display of or setting off of fireworks until New Year's Eve and New Year's Day. The Township of Tiny's Municipal Law Enforcement Officers will be enforcing instances of non-compliance. Concerns regarding non-compliance can be reported to the Municipal Law Enforcement Department at 705-526-4136. Non-compliance may result in the issuance of a warning, a charge with a fine of \$180.00 or a Summons to appear in court.
