Municipal Law Enforcement Update August 13 to 15, 2021

(**Tiny, Ontario**) Over the period of August 13 to 15, 2021, the Township of Tiny By-law Officers were on full patrol responding to calls that range from noise, dogs, litter, fireworks and COVID-related complaints.

As a result, Township By-law Officers patrolled a total of 304 km via bike patrol and responded to 54 complaints. By-law Officers issued 84 parking tickets for illegally parked vehicles. Please visit our website for current parking regulations at www.tiny.ca/parking.

As per [By-law #02-115](#) dogs are prohibited on Balm Beach between June 1 and September 30. By-law Officers issued one (1) charge for a dog on Balm Beach.

The Township of Tiny would like to remind the community that fireworks [By-law 07-054](#), as amended, **prohibits the display of or setting off of fireworks** until New Year's Eve and New Year's Day. The Township of Tiny's Municipal Law Enforcement Officers will be enforcing instances of non-compliance. Concerns regarding non-compliance can be reported to the Municipal Law Enforcement Department at 705-526-4136. Non-compliance may result in the issuance of a warning, a charge with a fine of \$180.00 or a Summons to appear in court.
