Municipal Law Enforcement Update September 3 to 6, 2021

Date: September 10, 2021

(**Tiny, Ontario**) Over the period of September 3 to 6, 2021, the Township of Tiny By-law Officers were on full patrol responding to calls that range from noise, dogs, litter, fireworks and COVID-related complaints.

As a result, Township By-law Officers patrolled a total of 404 kilometers via bike patrol and responded to 79 complaints. By-law Officers issued 62 parking tickets for illegally parked vehicles. Please visit our website for current parking regulations at www.tiny.ca/parking.

By-law Officers also issued one (1) charge for use of a barbeque on the beach. As per [By-law 12-032](#), Section 7, no person shall be permitted to have a barbeque upon any boardwalk or beach owned by the Township of Tiny.

By-law Officers issued one charge burning without a Burning Permit which has a fine of \$365.00 and one charge for failing to comply with the Terms and Conditions of a Class "A" Burning Permit which has a fine of \$180.00.

Fire permits can be purchased at the Township of Tiny Office, at 130 Balm Beach Road West, Perkinsfield Monday to Friday (9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.). The Township of Tiny would like to remind the community that fireworks [By-law 07-054](#), as amended, **prohibits the display of or setting off of fireworks** until New Year's Eve and New Year's Day. The Township of Tiny's Municipal Law Enforcement Officers will be enforcing instances of non-compliance. Concerns regarding non-compliance can be reported to the Municipal Law Enforcement Department at 705-526-4136. Non-compliance may result in the issuance of a warning, a charge with a fine of \$180.00 or a Summons to appear in court.
