Municipal Law Enforcement Update May 27 to 29, 2022

Date: May 30, 2022

(Tiny, Ontario) Over the period of May 27 to 29, 2022, the Township of Tiny By-law Officers were on full patrol responding to calls ranging from noise enforcement, illegal use of fireworks on public property, and failure to obtain a burn permit.

As a result, Township By-law Officers patrolled a total of 262 km via bike patrol and responded to 41 complaints. By-law Officers issued 14 parking tickets for illegally parked vehicles. For current parking regulations visit the Township's website at www.tiny.ca/parking.
