Municipal Law Enforcement Update July 1 to 3, 2022

Date: July 5, 2022

(Tiny, Ontario) Over the period of July 1 to 3, Township of Tiny By-law Officers were on full patrol responding to calls ranging from noise complaints to illegal parking and dog complaints.

Offence Type	Charge(s)
Cawaja Beach Parks By-law - Permit animal on the beach between 10am to 6pm (June 15 - September 15)	1
Dog By-law - Permit dog on Balm Beach between June 1 and September 30	2
Dog By-law - Permit Dog to run at large	2
Fireworks By-law – set off fireworks on public property without authorization	3
Fireworks By-law – set off fireworks on unauthorized day	2
Noise By-law – cause or permit a noise from any electronic device or other sound producing equipment	4
Open Air Burning By-law – Fail to obtain a burn permit	1
Parks By-law – operate motorized machine in a park	2
Parks By-law – have barbeque upon municipal beach	1
Watering By-law – use water not during permitted time	1

The Township of Tiny would like to remind the community that fireworks [By-law 21-102](#) prohibit the display of or setting off fireworks outside of Victoria Day, Canada Day, New Year's Eve, and New Year's Day. The discharge of fireworks is strictly prohibited within the municipality outside of these four days. Concerns regarding non-compliance can be reported to the Municipal Law Enforcement Department at 705-526-4136. Non-compliance may result in the issuance of a warning, a charge with fines ranging from \$365.00 to \$100,000.00, or a Summons to appear in court.
