Municipal Law Enforcement Update July 29 to August 1, 2022

(Tiny, Ontario) Over the period of July 29 to August 1, Township By-law Officers were on full patrol responding to calls ranging from noise complaints to illegal parking and dog complaints.

Offence Type	Charge(s)
Dog By-law - Permit dog on Balm Beach between June 1 and September 30	3
Noise By-Law – Cause or permit noise from any electronic device or other sound-producing equipment	2
Parks By-Law – Light, set, stoke, or maintain a fire in a park	1
Parks By-law – Having a Barbeque on a municipal beach	1

Township By-law Officers patrolled a total of 331 km via bikes and responded to 87 complaints. By-law Officers issued 222 parking tickets for illegally parked vehicles. For current parking regulations visit the Township’s website at www.tiny.ca/parking.
