Municipal Law Enforcement Update August 5 to 7, 2022

(Tiny, Ontario) Over the period of August 5 to 7, Township By-law Officers were on full patrol responding to calls ranging from noise complaints to illegal parking and dog complaints.

Offence Type	Charge(s)
Dog By-law - Permit dog on Balm Beach between June 1 and September 30	2
Noise By-Law – Cause or permit noise by yelling, shouting, or ringing bells	1

Township By-law Officers patrolled a total of 110 km via bikes and responded to 55 complaints. By-law Officers issued 109 parking tickets for illegally parked vehicles. For current parking regulations visit the Township’s website at www.tiny.ca/parking.
