(**Tiny, Ontario**) Over the period of September 2 to 5, 2022, Township By-law Officers were on full patrol responding to calls ranging from noise complaints to illegal parking and dog complaints.

Offence Type	Charge(s)
Dog By-law - Permit dog on Balm Beach between June 1 and September 30	1
Fireworks By-law – set off fireworks on an unauthorized day	1
Noise By-law – cause or permit a noise from any electronic device or other sound- producing equipment	1
