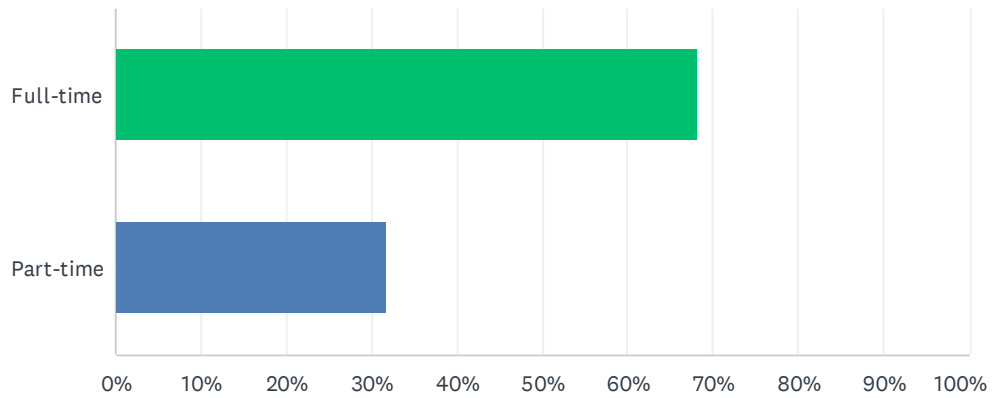

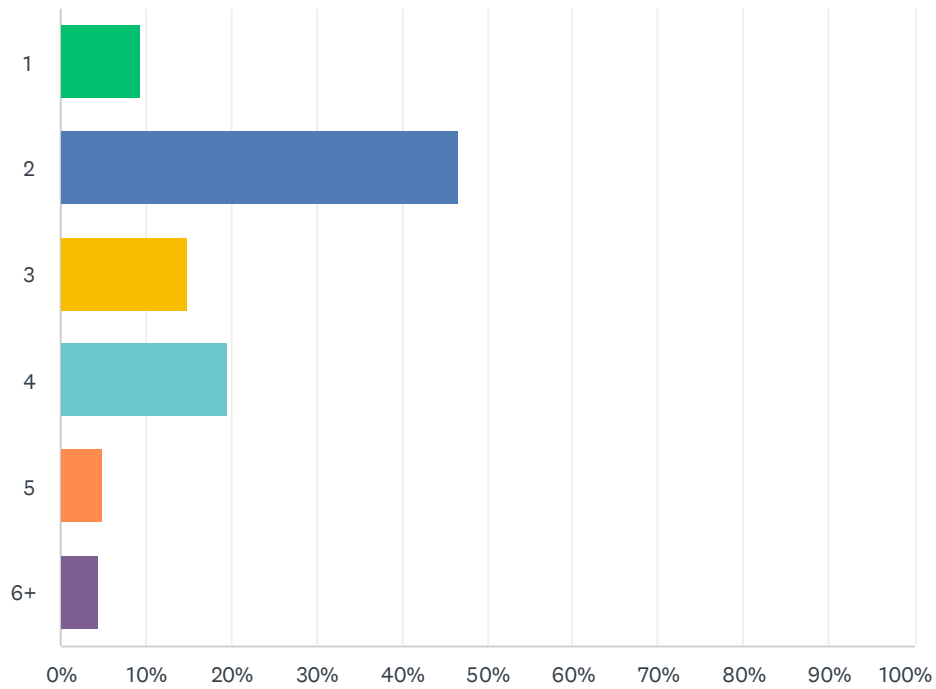

Q3 How many people live in your home?

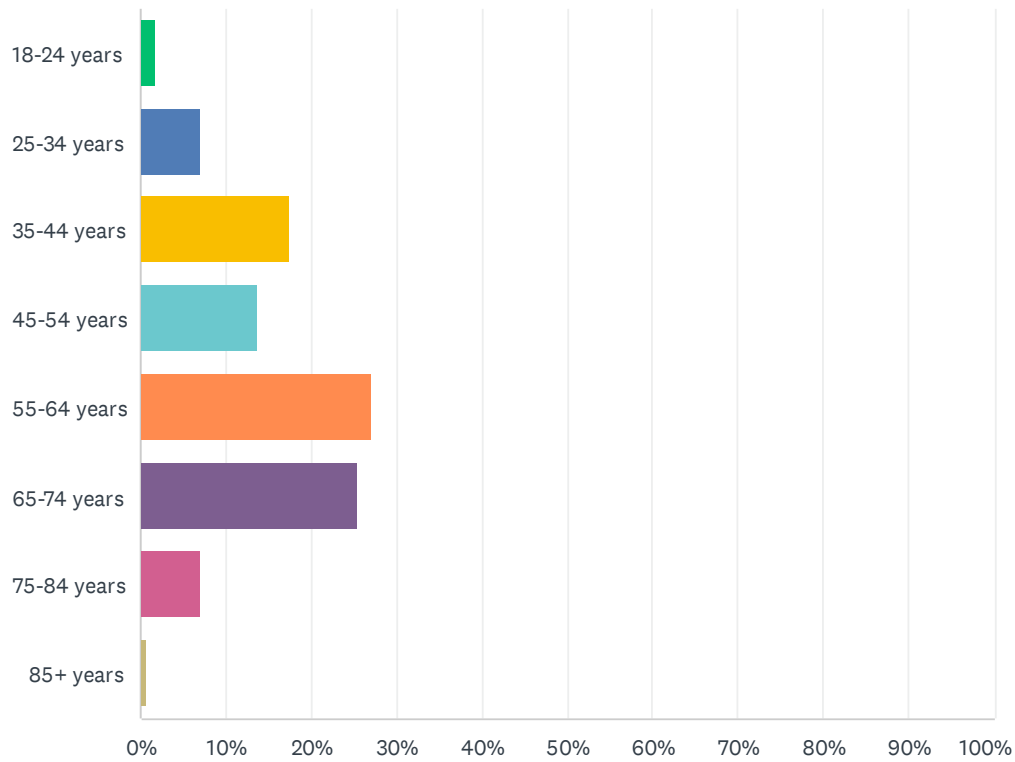

Q4 What is the age of the person filling out this survey?

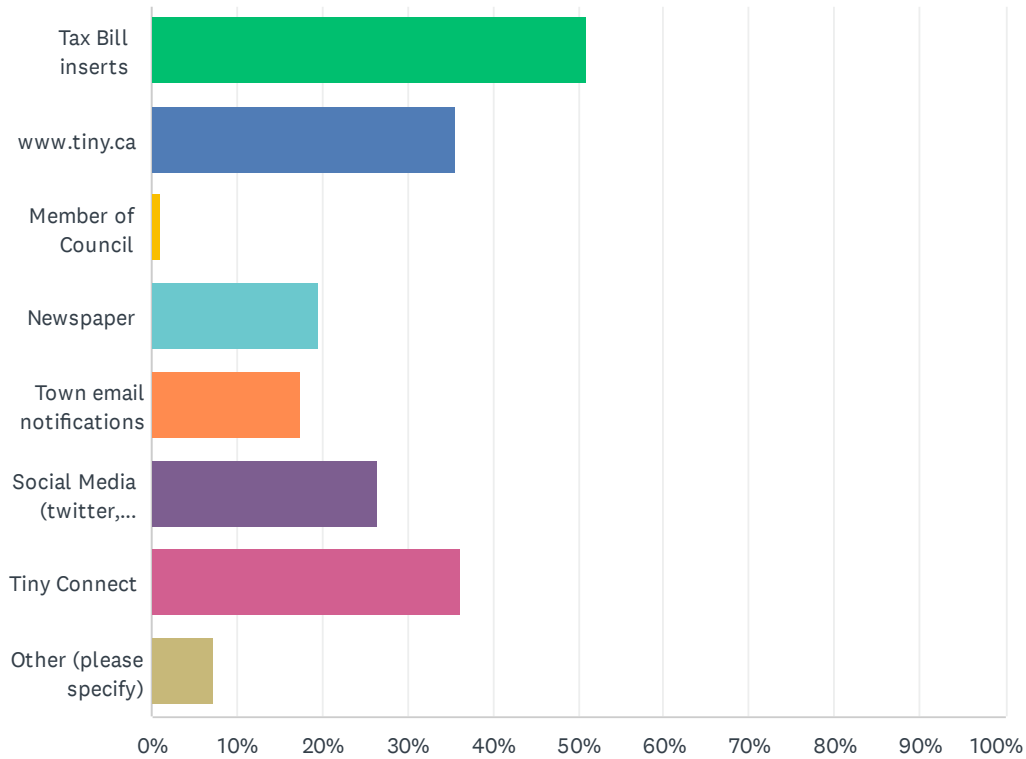

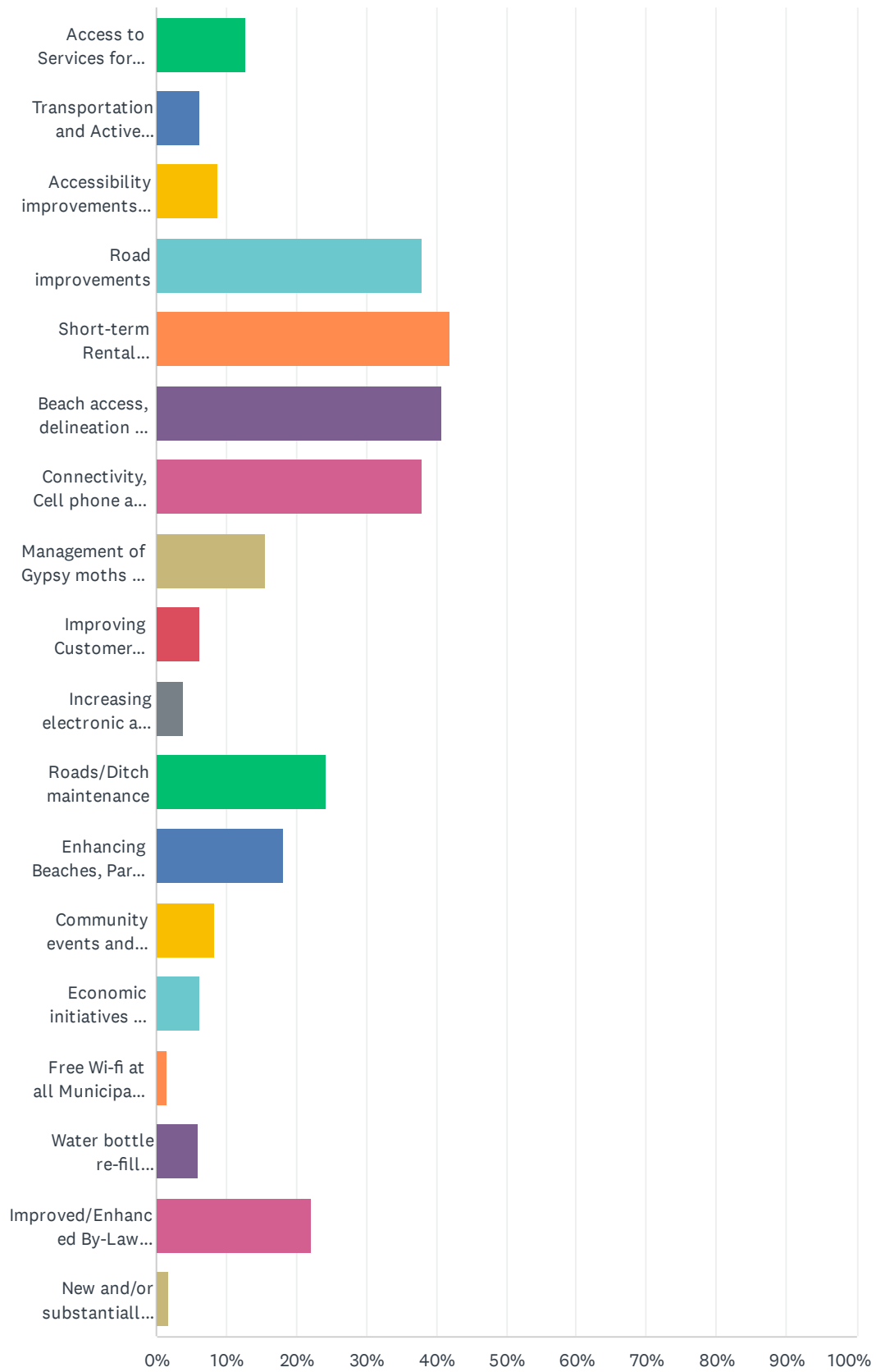

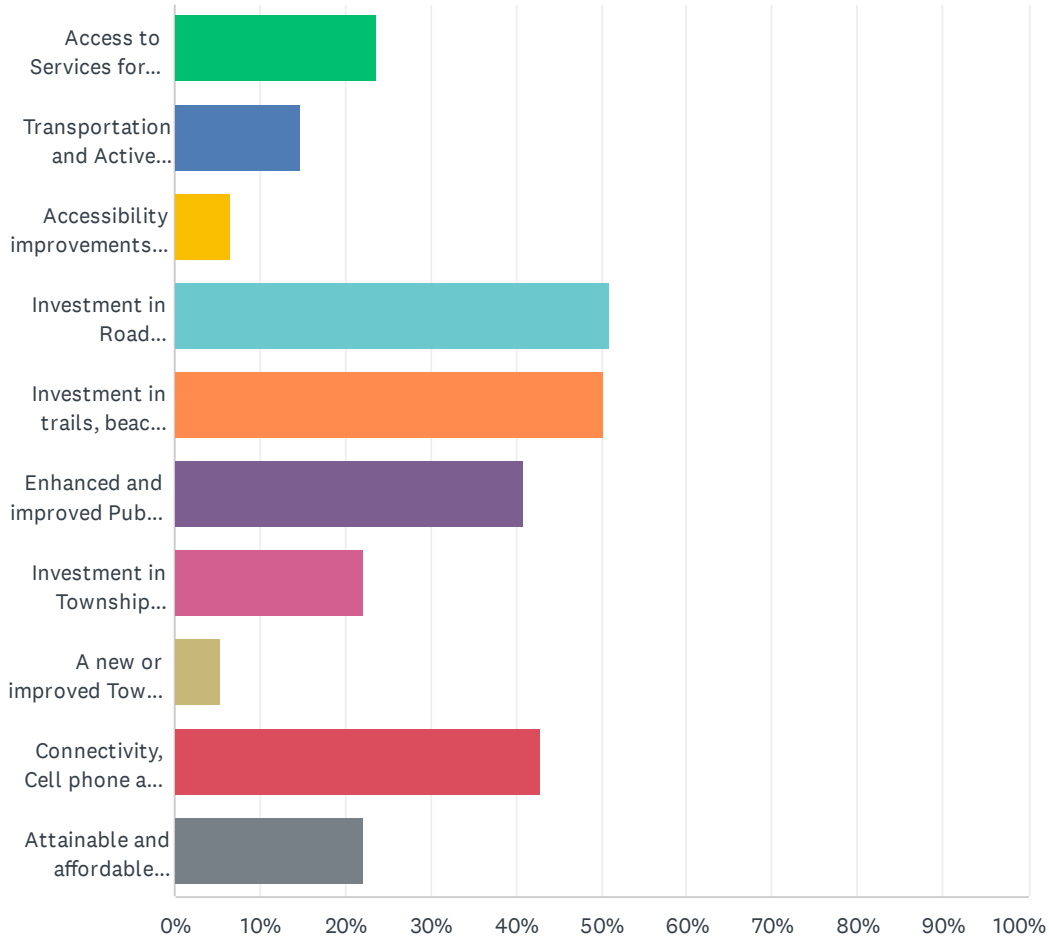

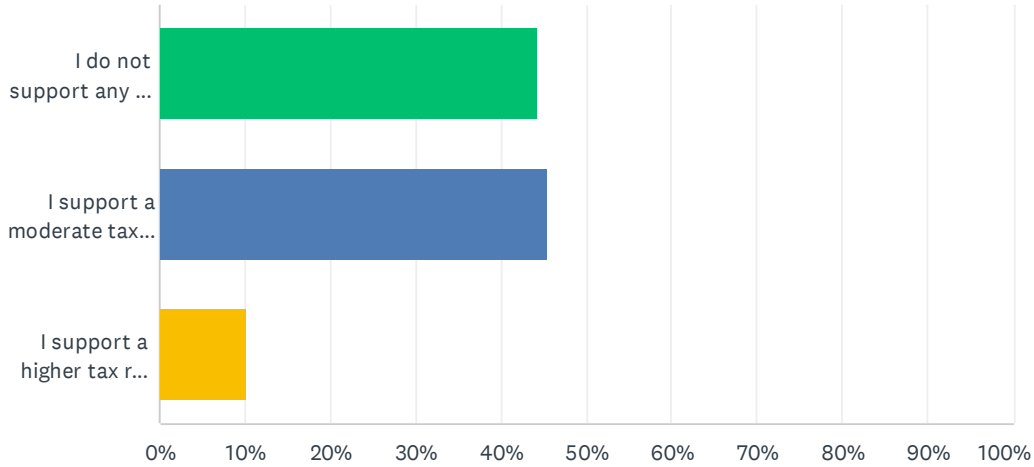

Q8 Which statement best represents your position regarding the tax dollars you pay in Tiny;

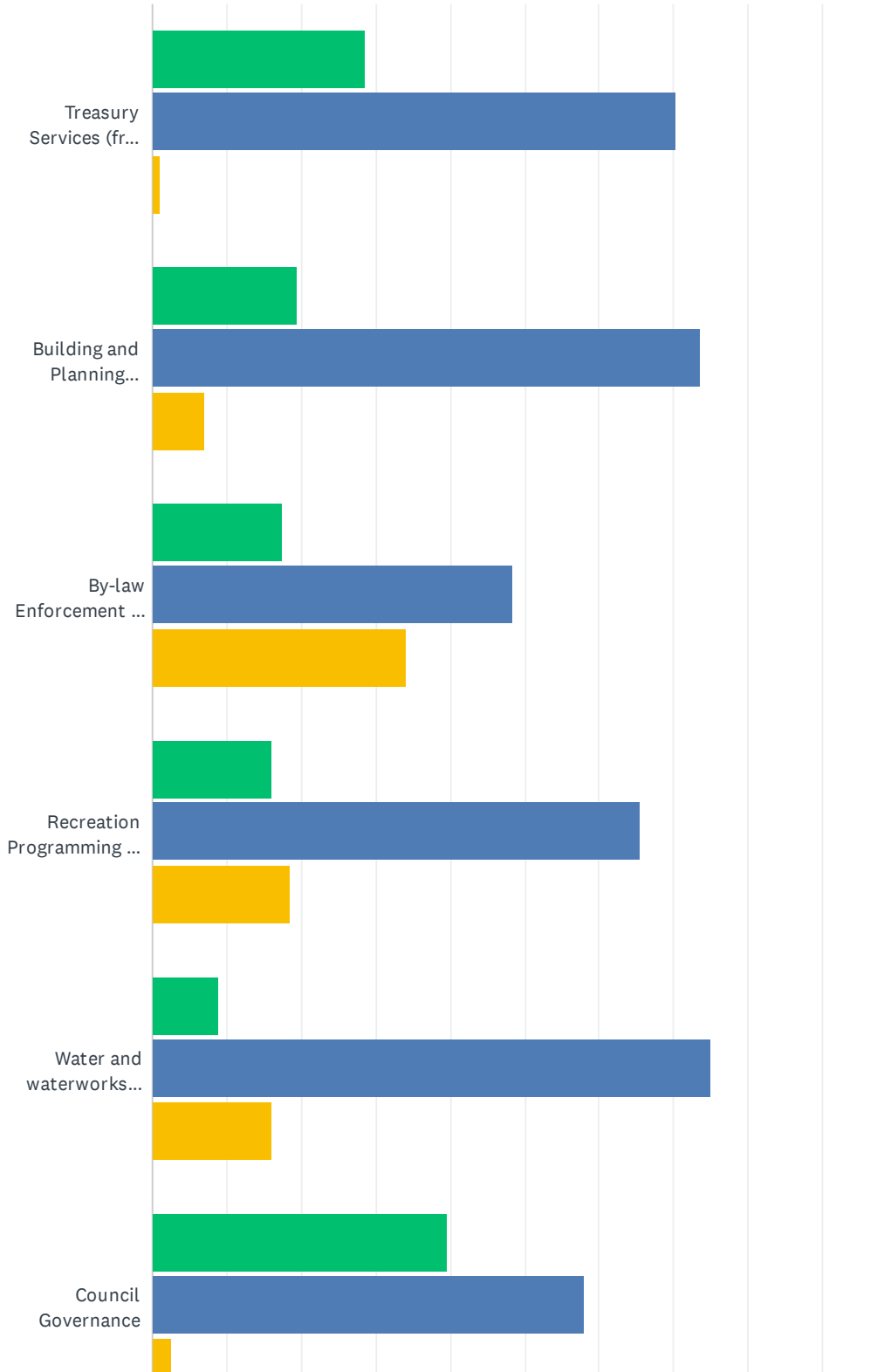

As we know, when rising tides lift all boats as we have seen with property value assessments going up dramatically, elected officials need to consider how this effects property tax fairness. As a Tiny Township property owner either your taxes have gone up dramatically because your neighborhood has seen homes or cottages sell for hundreds of thousands of dollars more than what they where just two or three years ago or you live in dread that one of your neighbors will sell and your property re-assessed. If you are a fortunate and live on a street that no neighbor has sold their farm, home cottage or empty lot, your property value assessment and Tiny Township tax has not changed. However, just a block away – a homeowner with a property just like yours has seen neighbors sell and now their home has been re-assessed resulting in skyrocketing Tiny Township property tax. That is not fair taxation. Professionally managed municipalities deal with this problem by actively publishing and adjusting their Mil rate to establish fairness and only tax their citizens to meet the most basic and core operational budget needs while keeping a firm hand on discretionary costs and salary increases. I have also talked to my neighbors who like me, are retired and on fixed income who have expressed real concern that Tiny Township Council unconsciously plans to tax us out of our homes on the back of property value assessment. On the topic of investment frugality, we do not want more Township paid services or additional administrative staff added to cater to special interest groups in Tiny Township. Council members should be ultra sensitive to all requests by the vocal minority and friends of Tiny Township decision makers who demand new spending on recreation, health or educational funding that benefits the few at the expense of the many taxpayers who would never use these services.
