Non-resident applications open:	December 12th, 2022 @ 12:00pm
Application deadline:	December 19th, 2022 @ 12:00pm
Session #3:	February 21st to April 5th, 2023
Resident applications open:	January 30th, 2023 @ 12:00pm
Non-resident applications open:	February 6th, 2023 @ 12:00pm
Application deadline:	February 13th, 2023 @ 12:00pm

In order to enter the lottery, players are required to register as a team consisting of 4 to 6 members. Team representatives will register on behalf of the team and players will be limited to 1 team per session to ensure equal opportunity of play for all. Registration is on a first come, first serve basis and limited spots are available.

Team representatives will be contacted the day after the application deadline between 12:00pm and 1:00pm with the results of the lottery and with the opportunity to select their team's time slot. Teams should discuss the groups availability and preferences beforehand. In fairness of other participants, the Township cannot make accommodations or modifications to the schedule or lottery system. If your team is unable to accommodate remaining time slots of the lottery, you may request a withdrawal and will subsequently be refunded.
