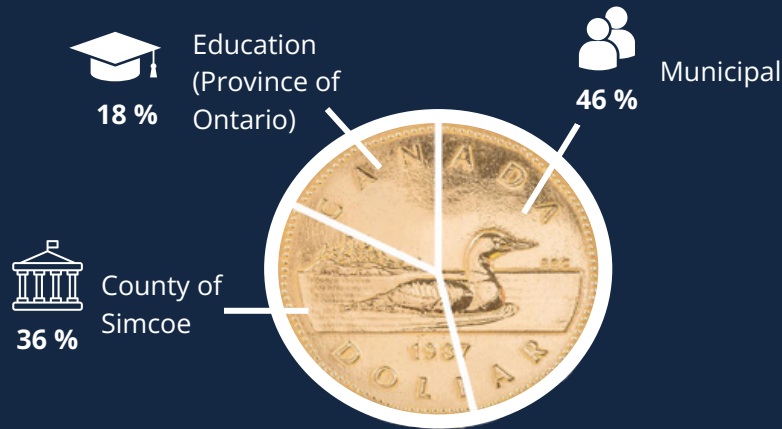


Where do your tax dollars go?

How are tax dollars allocated?

For every tax dollar collected, the Township of Tiny receives 46 cents, the County of Simcoe receives 36 cents, and the Province of Ontario receives 18 cents for education.



What will my property taxes be?



Property taxes are calculated by using the blended tax rate which is made up of the municipal, county, and provincial (education) tax rates. The 2024 blended tax rate increase is 5.03 per cent. Property owners can use this blended rate to calculate their property tax increase by taking the total amount of taxes paid last year and multiplying by the blended tax rate increase per cent, provided your assessment value has not changed.

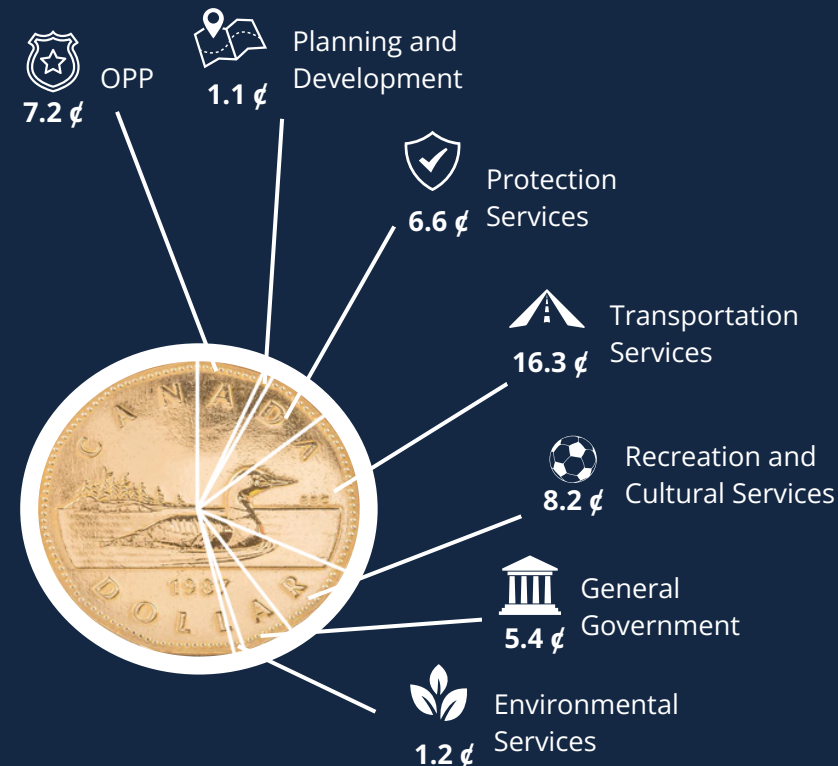
Total Taxes Example:

- A \$1,000 total tax bill (found by adding all taxes paid in 2023 together) multiplied by 5.03 per cent would be a total tax bill of \$1,050.30 in 2024.

How much money goes toward township services out of the 46 cents per dollar?

Of the 46 cents per dollar that the Township of Tiny receives, the taxes are divided to support township services as follows:

- Ontario Provincial Police (OPP): 7.2 cents
- Planning and Development: 1.1 cents
- Protection Services (By-law and Fire): 6.6 cents
- Transportation Services: 16.3 cents
- Recreation and Cultural Services: 8.2 cents
- General Government: 5.4 cents
- Environmental Services: 1.2 cents



How much money goes toward the Ontario Provincial Police (OPP)?



Of the 46 cents per dollar that the Township of Tiny receives, the OPP receives 7.2 cents from the township portion which is approximately 15.6 per cent of the township's budget. This means the township keeps 38.8 cents per tax dollar to support a broad range of municipal services for our residents.

For example:

If your residential property was assessed at \$350,000 in 2024, and the municipal tax rate is 8.19 per cent:

- Municipal increase: \$88.22
- OPP increase: \$16.29
- Total: \$104.51

Meaning, for every \$100,000 in assessed value:

- Municipal increase: \$25.20
- OPP increase: \$4.65
- Total: \$29.86
