

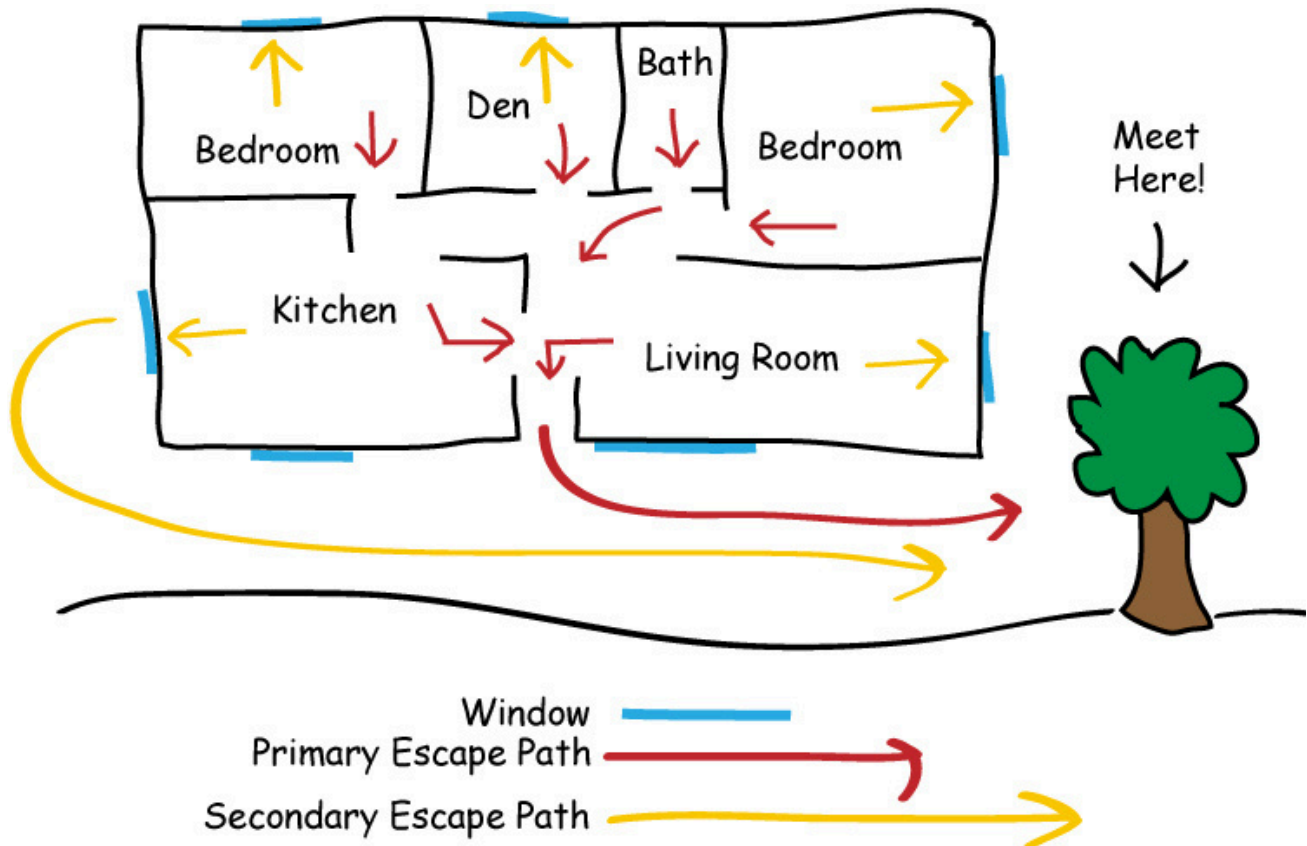
Fire Escape Plan

Develop a fire escape plan today! Every second counts when you are trying to escape a fire.

1. Draw a floor plan of your home (use the grid on the back)



- Include all possible emergency exits such as doors, windows, and stairways.
- Include any features such as the roof of a garage or porch that could help you escape.

- Show two ways out of every room (if possible).
- Plan for any members of your household that may need assistance to escape (i.e. kids, older adults, or those with disabilities).

2. Make a plan for the whole household

- Choose a meeting place outside. Ensure it is a safe distance away from the home and will be easy to remember.
- Once safely outside, call 9-1-1 from a cellphone or from a neighbour's home.

3. Practice your escape

- Review the plan with everyone in your household.
- Walk through the escape routes for each room with the entire household.
- Hold a fire drill at least twice per year, and make it realistic - pretend certain exits are blocked by fire and have everyone find an alternate escape route.
