

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TINY

BY-LAW 26-016

**Being a By-law to set the Remuneration of Council
and to Repeal By-law 25-011**

WHEREAS Section 8 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, (the "Municipal Act") provides that the powers of a municipality under the Municipal Act or any other Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS Section 11 of the Municipal Act authorizes a lower tier municipality to provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public and includes the power pass by-laws with respect to those matters for which it has jurisdiction pursuant to the Municipal Act;

AND WHEREAS Section 283 of the Municipal Act provides that a municipality may pay any part of the remuneration and expenses of any local board of the municipality and of the officers and employees of the local board.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Tiny enacts as follows:

1. Short Title

- 1.1. This By-law shall be referred to as the "Council Remuneration By-law."

2. General Provisions

Office	Annual Remuneration Effective January 1, 2026
Mayor	\$44,770.89
Deputy Mayor	\$33,578.62
Councillor	\$29,100.78

- 2.1. The above remuneration shall be considered as full compensation for the following:

- 2.1.1. Regular Committee of the Whole Meetings;
- 2.1.2. Regular Meetings of Council;
- 2.1.3. Voluntary attendance at association meetings, public events, etc.;
- 2.1.4. Voluntary attendance to committees to which they have not been appointed by resolution or by-law.

Note: Meetings before/after the Committee of the Whole and Meetings of Council are not eligible for payment.

- 2.2. A per diem rate of \$60.00 per half day (4 hours or less) and \$120.00 per full day shall be paid to members of Council appointed by by-law to attend the following meetings:

- 2.2.1. Accessibility Advisory Committee;
- 2.2.2. Great Lakes St. Lawrence Cities Initiative;

- 2.2.3. Heritage Advisory Committee;
 - 2.2.4. Huronia Airport Commission;
 - 2.2.5. Municipal Emergency Control Group;
 - 2.2.6. Township of Tiny Administrative Centre Committee;
 - 2.2.7. Township of Tiny Administrative Centre Ad Hoc Committee;
 - 2.2.8. Township of Tiny Events and Charities Committee (formerly the Mayor's Charity Golf Tournament Working Committee);
 - 2.2.9. North Simcoe Heads of Council;
 - 2.2.10. Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee;
 - 2.2.11. Southern Georgian Bay O.P.P. Detachment Board;
 - 2.2.12. Senior Advisory Committee;
 - 2.2.13. Severn Sound Environmental Association;
 - 2.2.14. Southern Georgian Bay Physician Recruitment;
 - 2.2.15. Any other Council approved Advisory Committee to be added by By-law of Council during the year, as required.
- 2.3. A per diem of \$60.00 per half day (4 hours or less) and \$120.00 per full day shall be paid to Council members to attend the following:
- 2.3.1. Special Committee of the Whole Meetings and Special Meetings of Council, and including but not limited to:
 - 2.3.1.1. Annual Budget Meetings;
 - 2.3.1.2. Council Orientation;
 - 2.3.1.3. Council Education/Training Sessions;
 - 2.3.1.4. Professional Development.
 - 2.3.2. Town Hall Meetings;
 - 2.3.3. Public meetings which are part of the public planning process, excluding public meetings which are held prior to a Regular Meeting of Council, and for attendance at meeting/functions not specifically referred to in this by-law but approved by Council.
- 2.4. Eligible Council members shall be enrolled in the Ontario Municipal Employment Retirement System (OMERS) as per Township of Tiny By-law 19-025. Council members who are deemed ineligible, will receive a payment in lieu of OMERS.
- 2.5. Mileage at rate set by Federal Government is payable to all members of Council when using their own vehicles to travel for Township business within and outside of the boundaries of the Township and excluding travel to and from the Township office.

Note: Mileage is calculated from the Council member's residence.

- 2.6. The municipality will provide a highspeed internet connection, including installation and activation, for each member of Council. The municipality will reimburse up to 50% of the monthly charge incurred to a maximum of \$50 per month, upon annual submission of one copy of the member of Council's invoice for service.
 - 2.7. The municipality will reimburse up to 50% of the monthly fees incurred for cellular telephone charges, to a maximum of \$45 per month, upon submission of one copy of the member of Council's invoice for service.
 - 2.8. Each member of Council shall be issued one Parking Permit per year while serving on Council.
 - 2.9. The Municipality shall not compensate members of Council for attendance at meetings of County Council and County committees unless approved by Council.
 - 2.10. Remuneration to members of Council shall be paid on a prorated bi-weekly basis.
 - 2.11. Expense claims must be approved by the Chief Administrative Officer or the Director of Corporate Services.
 - 2.12. The change in the annual remuneration represents an overall salary increase of 2.4%.
3. **Repeal**
 - 3.1. That By-law 25-011 is hereby repealed.
 4. **Force and Effect**
 - 4.1. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of passing.
