## Township of TINY – 2026 Emergency Preparedness Week Contest Terms and Conditions

### Contest Organizer

The 2026 Emergency Preparedness Week Contest (“the **Contest**”) is organized by the Township of Tiny (“the **Contest Organizer**”). The address at which the Contest Organizer may be contacted is 130 Balm Beach Road West, Tiny, Ontario L0L 2J0.

### Eligibility

The Contest is open to entrants who, as of the date of entry, are: a legal resident of Canada (excluding the Province of Quebec<sup>1</sup>) AND a resident or property owner in the Township of Tiny.

To be eligible, the entrant must complete in full, the 2026 Emergency Preparedness Week Contest Questionnaire (“**Contest Questionnaire**”). No purchase necessary. Entries are limited to one per person.

Eligible participants 18 years or older will be automatically entered into the draw upon completion of answering all of the questions in the Contest Questionnaire.

Entrants under the age of 18 may complete the Contest Questionnaire but must have the consent of their parent or legal guardian to participate. If a minor entrant is selected as a potential winner, the parent or legal guardian must sign all required documents and fulfill all winner-related required actions and obligations on the minor’s behalf. For the avoidance of doubt, with respect to minor entrants, all obligations assigned in these Rules to the “entrant,” “participant,” “winner,” or “you” apply to the minor entrant’s parent or legal guardian, who must perform all required actions and accept all obligations on the minor entrant’s behalf. Providing false, incomplete, or fraudulent consent will result in immediate disqualification of the minor’s entry and forfeiture of any prize awarded, at Contest Organizer’s sole discretion.

Eligible participants under 18 years of age will be entered into the draw upon completion of answering all questions in the Contest Questionnaire with a legal guardian’s consent.

The following individuals are not eligible to participate:

- employees of the Township of Tiny and their immediate family members or persons residing in the same household; and
- members of Township of Tiny Council, and their immediate family members or persons residing in the same household.

Entrants must have internet access in order to enter. The Contest is subject to all applicable federal, provincial, and local laws and regulations and is void where prohibited.

The entry period for the Contest shall begin at 10:00 a.m. (EST) on May 4, 2026, and ends at 11:59 p.m. (EST) on May 10, 2026, (“the **Contest Period**”). The Contest Organizer’s computer is the official timekeeper of the Contest. Entries received other than during the Contest Period, and duplicate entries, will be determined ineligible and discarded.

## How to Enter

There is only one (1) way to enter the Contest, which is online:

- a. During the Contest Period, visit the website [www.tiny.ca/prepare](http://www.tiny.ca/prepare) and complete all questions in the Contest Questionnaire.
- b. For all entries: Limit: One (1) entry per person and per email address during the Contest Period. The Contest Organizer will not be responsible for incomplete, lost, late, misdirected or illegible registration or failure to receive entry. Any entry that does not comply with any aspect of these Official Rules, as determined by Contest Organizer in its sole discretion, may be rejected by Contest Organizer and the entrant disqualified. Proof of submission will not be deemed proof of receipt of entry by Contest Organizer. All entrants and entries are subject to verification prior to the awarding of a prize, as are the eligibility, age and other claims of/information provided by a potential prize winner. Any entries attempted through the use of agencies or robotic, repetitive, automatic, programmed or similar methods will be void. Wireless carrier’s data rates may apply if an entrant enters the Contest using a mobile device. All entries become the exclusive property of Contest Organizer and none will be acknowledged or returned. Entrants will cooperate with Contest Organizer and its representatives in connection with any and all verification activities. All entries that are incomplete, illegible, damaged, irregular, have been submitted through illicit means, or do not conform to or satisfy any condition of the Official Rules (as defined below) may be disqualified by Contest Organizer.

## Agreement to Official Rules and Decisions

The Contest will be run in accordance with these Official Rules, subject to amendment by Contest Organizer (the “**Official Rules**”). Entrants must comply with the Official Rules and will be deemed to have received and understood the Official Rules by participating in the Contest. The terms of the Contest, as set out in the Official Rules, are not subject to amendment or counter-offer, except as set out herein. The Contest Organizer’s decisions with respect to the Contest (including, without limitation, decisions regarding eligibility of entries, the selection of entrants and winners, and awarding of the Prizes) are final and binding. If any provisions of the Official Rules are held to be invalid or unenforceable, all remaining provisions hereof will remain in full force and effect.

## Winner Selection

Entrants must respond to all questions in the Contest Questionnaire to qualify for entry. The draw will take place on or about May 12, 2026. Each of the three (3) potential winners will be selected by random draw from all eligible participants. Before being declared a winner, each

selected entrant must correctly answer, without assistance, a mathematical skill-testing question within five (5) minutes.

Winners will be notified by email or phone (supplied within the Contest Questionnaire) within five (5) business days of the draw date. If a winner cannot be reached within ten (10) business days, fails to correctly answer the skill-testing question, or if eligibility cannot be confirmed, the prize will be forfeited and an alternate winner will be selected by random draw.

- The odds of winning will be determined by the number of eligible entries received.
- The Township will use the contact information you have provided on the Contest Questionnaire to notify the potential winners to claim your prize.
- The Contest Organizer may require proof of identity and residence or eligibility to enter this contest (e.g., government-issued ID, proof of residence, etc.). Failure to provide such proof within five (5) business days of request will result in disqualification.

The Township reserves the right to refuse or reject your contest entry if:

- you attempt to enter the contest in an unauthorized manner;
- your entry is not in compliance with the contest Official Rules;
- your entry contains false or misleading information;
- your entry is late, illegible, incomplete, or otherwise irregular; or
- for any other reason as the Contest Organizer may determine.

## Prize

Subject to the terms and conditions of these Official Rules, three (3) prizes will be awarded in this Contest. The three (3) prizes will be drawn at random in order of first, second, and third prize, valued between approximately \$15 to \$250 (CAD) as follows:

- First prize includes a 72hr food supply kit, emergency radio, and emergency flashlight lantern valued at approximately \$250 (CAD).
- Second prize includes a 72hr food supply kit valued at approximately \$147 (CAD).
- Third prize includes an emergency flashlight lantern valued at approximately \$15 (CAD).

The Prize is non-transferable, non-assignable, non-negotiable, and not redeemable for cash or credit, except as otherwise provided in these Official Rules. Contest Organizer reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value if a prize becomes unavailable. To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, Prize is awarded "as is" with no warranty, condition, representation, or guarantee, express or implied, in fact or in law, made by Contest Organizer or for which Contest Organizer shall be liable including, without limitation, any implied warranties or conditions of merchantability, non-infringement or fitness for a particular purpose and winner assumes any and all risks of using the prize, including personal injury or death. The Contest Organizer's total liability shall not exceed the value of the Prize awarded.

The personal information provided on this form is collected under the authority of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, and is protected in accordance with *Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (MFIPPA). ## General Conditions

The Contest Organizer reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to terminate, modify or suspend the Contest if, in Contest Organizer's opinion, there is any suspected or actual evidence of electronic or non-electronic tampering with any portion of the Contest, or if viruses, bugs, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical difficulties or failures or any other factor beyond Contest Organizer's reasonable control corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the Contest.
